KNOWLEDGE

- Learn about man's special relationship with God through original solitude (TOB 5-6)
- Learn that Adam recognizes he is different from all other living beings by naming the animals (TOB 5:4)
- Learn that Adam is different from all other creatures because he can care for creation (TOB 6:3-7:2)
- Be introduced to the fact that man is self-aware and is given the ability to choose the good (TOB 6:1)

TOB TERMS

- **TOB** — Theology of the Body.
- **ORIGINAL SOLITUDE** — Man's experience of being alone in the garden of Eden before original sin. God uses this "aloneness" to show man:
 - Humans are different & superior to the animals.
 - Humans have the freedom to choose right from wrong.
 - Humans have a special relationship with God.
 - Humans are made for relationship with other humans.

CHARACTERS

- **SAL** — Sal is a little girl who goes blueberry picking with her mother.
- **SAL'S MOTHER** — She takes Sal blueberry picking on Blueberry Hill.
- **LITTLE BEAR** — Little bear is eating blueberries with his mother on Blueberry Hill.
- **MAMA BEAR** — She encourages her cub to eat lots of blueberries to prepare for winter.
