

## Additional Steps for Continuing with **CALLED TO BE MORE**

### **HOW TO CONTINUE USING CALLED TO BE MORE:**

We wanted to offer some suggestions for how to use *Called to be More* as you continue going through this curriculum with your staff. Consider the following:

**STEP 1:** Determine the frequency that you will be able to meet.

**STEP 2:** Create the structure of your meeting time:

**SUGGESTED ITINERARY:** Have everyone read the lesson before coming together. Begin your meeting in prayer. Then provide a brief summary of the lesson, as well as some time for discussion. Use any remaining time to complete an activity or to watch a suggested video. Then simply close your time together in prayer. **(EST. TIME: 1 hr 15mins)**

**STEP 3:** Assign lessons to each of your staff member so they can rotate who gives the summary. (You will remain the facilitator for prayer and discussion).

**STEP 4:** Begin meeting and discovering the beauty of God's original plan for life and love!

**IN CONCLUSION:**

We hope that you and your staff find these steps to be fruitful! Even if you only take small steps to begin, do not underestimate the power of even the smallest leap of faith. Christ himself said, "if you have faith as a grain of mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move; and nothing will be impossible to you." (Matt 17:20). As *Called to be More* reminds us, we were made for greatness. We pray that you will experience this to be true for your staff, as well as for yourself and even your family. As St. Catherine of Sienna said, "If you are what you should be, you will set the world on fire." Now go and set the world on fire.
